# Introduction to Undeclared Major

We cultivate global innovative talents in each field who can flexibly solve problems faced by individuals, Korean society, and international community



The Undeclared Major is an undergraduate program where adult learners from migrant backgrounds get admitted as non-faculty (without deciding on a faculty or a major) at the admission stage.

Students spend 1 year (Year 1) adapting to university life, improving their Korean communication skills, exploring departments and majors that suit them.

The remaining fruitful 3 years (Years 2-4) will be dedicated to earning a 4-year bachelor's degree in their chosen field of study.

### Work-Study Program

- Graduate in 8 semester if you take an average of 6 courses (18 credits) per semester → Graduation after 4 years
- If you don't have time, you can take a minimum number of credits (graduate in 9+ semesters) → Graduation after 4.5 years
- Early graduation if you meet graduation requirements and have a GPA of 3.0+ in all prior years of study → Graduation after 3~3.5 years

# Q A Frequently Asked Questions

**Is Kyung Hee Cyber University recognized as a regular 4-year university?  
How is it different from other offline four-year universities and colleges?**

As a four-year university authorized under the Higher Education Act of the Ministry of Education, Kyung Hee Cyber University offers online education. We award the same bachelor's degree as a regular university, and you can go on to graduate school and/or study abroad after graduation.

**How are classes and exams conducted?**

As long as you have Internet access, you can complete classes, exams, and assignments. However, exams and assignments can only be completed on a desktop. (Lectures can be taken on both desktop and mobile.)

**How do I apply and get admitted to KHCU?**

File online application ▶ Self-introduction and personality test ▶ Submission of admission documents  
▶ Announcement of successful applicants ▶ Registration of successful applicants  
\* The admissions process is conducted in Korean

**What documents are required for admission to the Undeclared Major?**

In addition to the common documents, you will need to submit additional documents to prove that you are a foreigner (copy of passport, etc.) and from a multicultural family (marriage certificate, basic certificate, family relationship certificate, etc.).

**What are the application fee and tuition?**

Students admitted to the Undeclared Major are granted a **50% tuition scholarship** until graduation.

\* Application fee is waived for foreigners and overseas residents

\* Actual admission fees are waived for overseas residents and foreigners
